Placing a call using Two-Stage Dialing to an Iridium Subscriber

Follow the instructions below on how to place a call to an Iridium subscriber using the Iridium Two-Stage Dialing service

NOTE: Iridium Two-Stage Dialing is a forwarding service which allows callers trying to reach an Iridium subscriber to dial an Arizona based number instead of dialing direct. Callers will only be charged the applicable long distance charges for calling Arizona as opposed to a much higher rate of calling the Iridium phone directly.

Solution: Calling an Iridium subscriber using Two-Stage Dialing

1. Dial 1-480-768-2500, a North American, Arizona-based number.
2. When prompted, enter the 12-digit Iridium number you wish to call starting with 8816-XXX-XXXXX.

Example: If your Iridium number is 8816-310-12345, callers dial 1-480-768-2500, and when prompted, enter your 12-digit Iridium number 8816-310-12345.
